

Notice of Race

Formula Fifteen Skiff
Victorian State Championships

The Formula Fifteen Skiff Association invites entries for the 2008/2009 Victorian Formula Fifteen Championships to be conducted in conjunction with the following events:

Round 1: FOAK Regatta, Chelsea YC, 8th & 9th Nov 2008 - Sunday afternoon race only.
To be sailed on the waters of Port Phillip Bay off Chelsea.

Round 2: Flinders Skiff Regatta, Flinders YC, 29th & 30th Nov 2008 – All races.
To be sailed on the waters of Westernport Bay off Flinders.

Round 3: Rhyll Australia Day Regatta, Rhyll YC, 24th & 25th Jan 2009 – Sunday racing only.
To be sailed on the waters of Westernport Bay off Rhyll.

Round 4: Black Rock Skiff Regatta, Black Rock YC, 21st & 22nd March 2009 – All races.
To be sailed on the waters of Port Phillip Bay off Black Rock.

The Organising Authority is the Formula Fifteen Skiff Association, the Chelsea Yacht Club, the Flinders Yacht Club, the Rhyll Yacht Club and the Black Rock Yacht Club.

1. Rules.

The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008* (except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions) The Formula Fifteen Skiff Association Class Rules and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. Advertising

The series is classified as a Category C event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 and the prescriptions of YA.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1 Entries will only be accepted from Formula Fifteen Skiff class yachts which comply with the Formula Fifteen Skiff Class Rules.

3.2 Skipper and crew shall both be members of Yachting Australia and shall both be financial members of the Formula Fifteen Skiff Association.

3.3 Competing boats shall enter each event according to the host club's entry requirements. There is no entry fee payable to the Formula Fifteen Skiff Association.
